



Piatra Neamț is situated on the river Bistrita, in the NE part of Romania, at the borther to the Carpatian Mountains to Transilvania. It has about 85.000 inhabitants and it is the capital of the Neamt County.

It is an old city and the places were inhabited since 12.000 years BC, thus a lot of historical places surrounds the present city. The sites surrounding the city are the evidence of its roots along the centuries.

The city is often called the "The Perl of Moldavia" due to its harmonious integration of the buildings into the natural background, mountains and rivers.





The center of the city is dominated by the central park and The Old Kingdom Courtyard, that still keeps the symbol of the city – the Stephan the Great Tower (1499) and the old church, built in 1497-1498.

The courtyard was recently re-built and repaired, keeping the main featuring of old times.






The courtyard is surrounded by museums, the theatre and has a huge zone where festivals, fairs, official ceremonies and other events are organized.



The Shelter for Homeless Adults, capacity of 35 persons












The residential Center for Adults, capacity of 70 persons
