








Our concern about Cultural Heritage

People with intellectual disabilities can not access cultural heritage or its full enjoyment due to lack of understanding. This also happens to other people with cognitive problems (older people) or with language difficulties (foreign people). Our main objective as organization is to make cultural heritage accessible from a cognitive point of view, encouraging the use of an accessible language, carrying out awareness-raising actions and claiming cognitive accessibility as a right. Of course, we also consider cultural heritage as a tool for cohesion, social inclusion and local development.



Our experience / past and present

Aspanias Burgos has actively collaborate with the city and the province of Burgos in terms of valuing its main tourist and heritage resources, and bringing them closer to people with intellectual or development disabilities. To stand out, among others, the participation and collaboration in the set of activities linked to the candidacy of Burgos as European City of Culture 2016; the work developed with the Atapuerca Foundation, the National Research Center on Human Evolution (CENIEH) and the University of Zaragoza for spread the knowledge about human evolution among people with intellectual disabilities (through the adaptation of didactic and training materials and the separation of bones from sediments); the collaboration with the Foundation for the Study of Dinosaurs in Castilla y León through the implementation of different informative actions; or the agreements reached to develop joint activities with the Contemporary Art Center of Burgos (CAB).

Our interest / present

In the same way, the city of Burgos is currently preparing the commemorative acts of the 8th centenary of the founding of the Cathedral of Burgos (1221 - 2021). To organize and coordinate them, the Foundation VIII Centenario has been created, in which Aspanias is an active member, the association has become part of the Board of the cultural foundation representing the social and health organizations of Burgos and its province. We are working in make the Cathedral accessible from a cognitive point of view.



Our interest / present and future

We have submitted in the frame of Erasmus+ a project called "Easy to Read Easy to Access". As Cultural Heritage remain as one priority of Erasmus+, we want to promote through this project an inclusive and accessible heritage, also for those people with cognitive difficulties. Result in September.

In the frame of ECHOES we want to valorize a natural heritage, the Geoparque de las Loras https://geoparquelasloras.es/, as a tool for social inclusion, cohesion and employment creation for disadvantaged people, for people with intellectual or development disability. We are ready to collaborate with the Municipality of Villadiego
